



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors ("this Board") takes the following action:

1. ADOPTS the Negative Declaration of Environmental Significance for the General Plan Amendment (County Files: GP#07-0006); DETERMINES that the project would not result in a significant impact on the environment, that the Initial Study/Environmental Checklist conducted for this project was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. §15000 et seq.), and the County's own CEQA Guidelines (together, "CEQA"), that the CEQA Initial Study/Environmental Checklist prepared for this project is adequate for the Board's actions and that the determination of no significant impact (Negative Declaration) reflects this Board's independent judgment and analysis; and, DIRECTS the Community Development Department to post the Notice of Determination of Negative Declaration of Environmental Significance with the County Clerk.
  
2. ADOPTS the General Plan Amendment related to the development of bicycle and pedestrian facilities (County File: GP# 07-0006), which would amend and add text in the Land Use Element, Open Space Element, and Transportation and Circulation Element and add a new map for the purpose of promoting the development of bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and as more fully described in Exhibit "2" to the Board Report, dated April 8, 2008, and ADOPTS this General Plan Amendment as the second of four consolidated amendments for calendar year 2008 to the mandatory elements of the Contra Costa County General Plan, 2005-2020, as permitted by State Planning Law.
